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Incredible Egyptians Topic – Spring Term 2023

As part of our topic this term Years 3 and 4 have a lot of exciting events happening.

Egyptian Tomb



We started our topic with a 'hook'. We transformed our music room into an Ancient Egyptian Tomb filled with Egyptian artefacts, statues, jewellery, papyrus paintings, Egyptian costumes, vases, sarcophagus and even a mummy. There was sand everywhere! The children crawled under tables (these were our tunnels) and used torches to help them discover incredible Egyptian artefacts. We had Egyptian music playing and the children very much enjoyed the experience. It certainly was an excellent start to our topic.

Visit

We will be visiting the **Brighton Museum** on **Thursday 2**nd **February**. This valuable educational visit will provide the children with a greater understanding of the Egyptian period through various galleries and workshops. They will find out more about the process of mummification through a hands-on activity, learn about ideas, beliefs and attitudes of the Egyptians, and learn about the history of archaeology. The trip will help to bring the past to life and provide the children with a memorable learning experience to enhance their understanding of their topic.



Children will need to come to school on trip day wearing school uniform, comfortable school shoes and with a waterproof coat. Each child should bring a packed lunch, as we will be eating on site. If your child has a hot meal booked, please ensure that you contact Chartwells to cancel this as soon as possible. Your child will need to be at school promptly by 8:55am on the day as the coach will be leaving school soon afterwards. We will be returning before the end of the school day, so children will be leaving school at usual time.

The children do not need to bring any money with them as we will not be visiting the gift shop on site.
